

Norton 360 Firewall “Port” Exceptions.

1. Click "Settings" on the top in the N360 main window.
2. In the new window, click "Firewall Protection Settings".
3. Next, click the "Firewall traffic Rules" tab.
4. Press the "Add" button on the bottom of the window.
5. Next follow in this order to forward your port:
 - i) Allow: Allow connections to match this rule
 - ii) Connections from other computers
 - iii) Any Computer
 - iv) The protocol you want to allow : TCP and UDP
 - v) On the same screen, click "Only communications that match all types of ports listed below.
 - vi) Press "Add" on the same window. Filter By: Individually specified ports. Locality : Local
On the box, enter your port number.
eg 137, 139, 445
1. Start Norton 360.
2. Click Settings.
3. Click Firewall Protection.
4. On the General Rules tab, click Add.
5. Click Permit, and then click Next.
6. Click Connections to and from other computers, and then click Next.
7. Click Only Specific Computer or Web sites listed below and then click Add.
8. Select Individually, enter the Ip address of the server computer and click Ok.
9. Click Next.
10. Click Only the types of communication or ports listed below and then click Add.
11. In the Specify Ports window, be sure the Individually specified ports and Remote option buttons are selected. In the port entry field below, enter 7000,55402.
12. Click OK, and then click Next.
13. Type the description of the network into the box, and then click Next.
12. Click Finish.
14. Select the new firewall rule for the network in the list and click Move Up until the rule is listed at the top of the list.
15. Click Apply and then click Close.
